

### ASIA NOW, Paris Asian Art Fair 20 - 23 October 2016

# ASIA NOW, the "boutique art fair" dedicated to contemporary Asian art, will take place from October 20 to 23, 2016, in a new exhibition space located at 9 Avenue Hoche in Paris.

For its second edition, ASIA NOW is broadening perspectives on contemporary Asian art and its growing market, showcasing both established and emerging artists to demonstrate its value and potential. ASIA NOW pursues its mission to uncover the richness and variety of artistic creation in Asia.

ASIA NOW will gather **over 30 galleries** (compared to 18 galleries in 2015), representing artists from more than **13 Asian territories** including Bangladesh, Cambodia, China, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Japan, the Philippines, Singapore, South Korea, Taiwan, Thailand, Tibet, and Vietnam.

Among those newly represented in the fair this year: **Blindspot Gallery** (Hong Kong) showcasing the works of a selection of photographers, including Trevor Yeung, and a mechanic installation of Leung Chi Wo, **Madeln Gallery** (Shanghai, China) presenting artists Xu Zhen, Wang Sishun, and Lu Pingyuan, exhibiting this year at the 11<sup>th</sup> Shanghai Biennale, **Rossi & Rossi** (Hong Kong; London, UK) exhibiting several Tibetan artists including Kesang Lamdark and Tenzing Rigdol, **Sundaram Tagore Gallery** (Singapore; Hong Kong; New York, US) with Hiroshi Senju, Kamolpan Chotvichai, Miya Ando, Kim Joon, Sohan Qadri, and Tayeba Begum Lipi who represented Bangladesh at the 56<sup>th</sup> Venice Biennale, **Tang Contemporary** (Beijing, China; Hong Kong; Bangkok, Thailand) showing artists Cai Lei, Xu Qu and Zhao Zhao, and **Gallery EXIT** (Hong Kong) who will present a solo exhibition of Kong Chun Hei.

Participating for the first time will be galleries **URANO** (Tokyo, Japan), showing Takahiro Iwasaki, Toshiyuki Konishi, Ishu Hanrecently nominated to represent Japan at the Venice Biennale 2017, Chi-Wen Gallery (Taipei, Taiwan) with Chien Chi-Chang, Fabien Fryns Fine Art (Beijing) with a project of Li Wei presenting for the first time in Europe at ASIA NOW, L-Art Gallery (Chengdu, China), with Zhang Tianiun, Zhang Ya and Zhou Hang (aka Mr. d. Mouse), Magician Space (Beijing), showing Liu Yefu paired with Paris-based artist Yao Qingmei, **Misa Shin Gallery** (Tokyo) focusing on Japanese artists Shomei Tomatsu, Tsuyoshi Ozawa and Yasuko Iba, Park Ryu Sook Gallery (Seoul, South Korea) with Seulgi Lee, Tabula Rasa Gallery (Beijing) with Zhong Yunshu, Tu Hongtao and Xiao Hua, news of the world (London) featuring Teow Yue Han and the Hanoi Doclab, The Columns Gallery (Seoul) with Um Tai Jung, Chang Sang Hwa, Kim Guilin, Park Seo Bo, Ha Chong Hyun and Hwang Hur, **The Drawing Room** (Makati City, Philippines) with a dual show of Gaston Damag and Manuel Ocampo, Vanguard Gallery (Shanghai, China) with Peng Yun, and the Galerie Paris-Beijing (Paris, France; Beijing; Brussels, Belgium) with Gong Jian, Chen Yujun & Chen Yufan, Fu Site, Song Kun, Wang Haiyang, and Li Jinghu who is exhibiting at Gwangju Biennale 2016.

Also featured are **Yeo Workshop** (Singapore), presenting Santi Wangchuan's works using various forms of textile, as well as **Edmond Gallery** (Berlin, Germany) with the photo-installations of Hu Weiyi.

Among the galleries already involved in ASIA NOW's 2015 edition: **313 Art Project** (Seoul) presenting Sooyoung Kwak and Seonghi Bahk, who was chosen to represent South Korea at the Venice Biennale 2017, **A2Z Art Gallery** (Paris; Hong Kong) showing Hom Nguyen, Zhang Lehua, Zhou Yilun and Ji Jun, **A Thousand Plateaus Art Space** (Chengdu), with Chen Qiulin, **CHOI&LAGER** (Seoul; Cologne, Germany), presenting Heinkuhn Oh and Ayoung Kim, who was artist-in-residence at the Palais de Tokyo in 2016, **ifa Gallery** (Brussels, Belgium) with Xu Zhe's video works, **Leo Xu Projects** (Shanghai) with Shanghaiborn and Brooklyn-based artist Pixy Yijun Liao, **Madga Danysz Gallery** (Paris; Shanghai; London), with Liu Bolin, JR, Li Hongbo, and Tadashi Kawamata, **Primo Marella Gallery** and **Primae Noctis Art Gallery** (Milan, Italy and Lugano, Switzerland) showcasing artists Chen Shaoxiong, He Sen, Jeremy Sharma, Farhan Siki, Kenji Sugiyama, Nguyen Thai Tuan, He Wei, and **Sa Sa Bassac** (Phnom Penh, Cambodia) with Than Sok, Chan Dany, Yim Maline, and Vuth Lyno.

ASIA NOW aims to create a close connection between the collector and artists and their works. The second edition will be staged in the intimate atmosphere of a Haussmannian building, through which visitors will be able to wander from one room to the other as they would in a collector's home.

#### THE PROGRAMME

An ideal platform for dialogue and exchange committed to the promotion of contemporary Asian art, ASIA NOW is extending its program for its second edition, with new projects and performances featured:

- A group exhibition curated by **Hervé Mikaeloff**, in collaboration with **Matthias Arndt** (founder of A3) will be dedicated to Southeast Asia's art scene, including artists from the Philippines and Indonesia such as Alfredo and Isabel Aquilizan, Eko Nugroho, Entang Wiharso, Hahan, Jose Santos, Kawayan de Guia, Manuel Ocampo, Marina Cruz, Natee Ultarit, Rodel Tapaya, and Sopheap Pich.

- At ASIA NOW, **Shang Xia** and **Christie's** will continue the dialogue on **Chinese Contemporary Design** having already had two years of successful collaboration in Shanghai, New York and Paris. Twelve pieces designed by Shang Xia – the leading brand of Chinese contemporary design and craft of Hermès group – will illustrate the creativity and vibrancy of today's China, a society that cares about its history and cultural legacy.

- **news of the world**, a not-for-profit organisation and research studio curated by **Pierre Coinde** will be presenting two projects which will reveal the thinking processes in contemporary visual media. It focuses on the creative process of Asian artists working within the context of globalization. There will be a non-stop screening of the **Hanoi Doclab** exhibition and a performance piece by Singaporean artist **Teow Yue Han**.

- A Women's Independence Art Show curated by **Magda Danysz**, commissioned by **Etam** to celebrate its 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary, will present the works of 10 artists including Li Hongbo, Stella Sujin, and Liu Bolin. The art commissions will be first unveiled at K11 art museum in Shanghai, then at ASIA NOW. After the fair, the artworks will be sold at a charity auction, the profits of which will be donated to the **Naked Heart Foundation** founded by **Natalia Vodianova**.
